Maths

During this half term, we will be working on our understanding of mass and weight using grams and kilograms. We will then be revisiting fractions to secure our knowledge, before focusing on money. Use any opportunities in the home to expose your children to scales and weights.

We will also be looking at the job of pollen and working on understanding the different ways that seeds can be spread.

History

How have children's lives changed?

In this unit, we will be exploring the changes in the lives of children and will be focusing on what jobs children had, what they enjoyed doing in their spare time and the illnesses they experienced. We will then compare to how children live now and discuss the changes.

Instruction writing: We will be looking at how to write instructions and what words/phrases are often used. We will be focusing on the use of timed adverbials and chronological ordering.

Persuasive writing: We will be looking at different pieces of persuasive writing. The children will be learning about all the features of persuasion and will be designing their own advert.

Recorder

The children will be learning how to play the recorder this term. They will be first learning about all the parts on a recorder and why they are important. The children will then be learning how to play some simple tunes and melodies.
