Spring term coverage: Geometry, Stats and Ratio

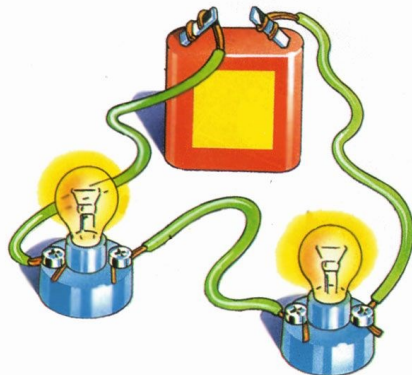

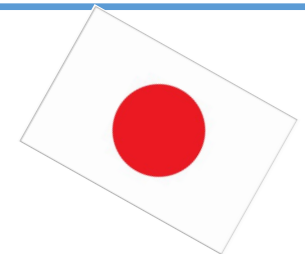
High Quality Texts: Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo
