Autumn 2 coverage: Multiplication and Division, Area, Perimeter and Volume

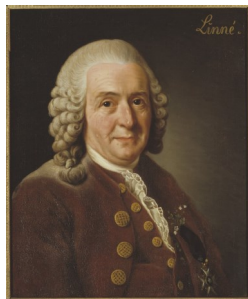
Ongoing: Arithmetic, Reasoning and Times Tables - Thank you for continuing to support learning at home via homework.

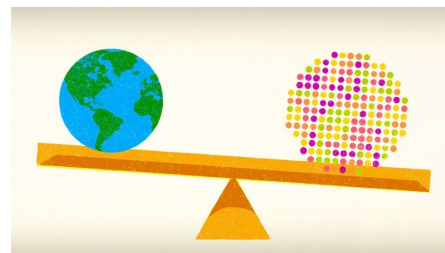

Advent

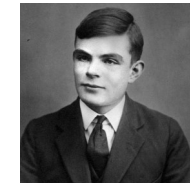
