### Communication, Language and Literacy

We continue to learn our phonic sounds through Super-sonic Phonics. We will learn new sounds and continue to embed the sounds we already know.

We will apply our sound knowledge when writing labels and simple phrases, focusing on forming our letters correctly.

We will listen to a wide range of fiction and non-fiction books within our theme. We will discuss the difference between the two types of books.

We will continue to develop our speaking and listening skills through small group sessions, directed sessions, WellComm and Show and Tell time.

We will listen carefully and ask questions, responding to what our friends say.

### Topic/Theme

#### Our Natural Environment & Living Things

We will be exploring lots of exciting natural history such as turtles, penguins and whales. We will enjoy a wide range of fiction and non-fiction books about our natural world. Children will recognize that some environments are different to the one in which they live. They will begin to understand the effect of the changing seasons on the natural world around them.

**Vocabulary:** endangered, scientist, shell, ocean, mysterious, driftwood, whale, compass, Emperor Penguin, Loggerhead Turtle, skeeter, journey, shoal, kelp, coral reef, add, all together, shorter, longer, lighter, bigger, smaller, more, less, fewer, equals, the same as, five frame, tens frame.
