Further opening of schools March 8th 2021

We are very excited to see you all on March 8th.

Please read and follow these safety instructions to help keep our community safe.

Symptoms, asymptomatic and tests

If your **child, or anyone in your family has any** symptoms that could be related to Coronavirus please **do not send them into school. Get a test** to help protect your family and the school family.

If any child has been in contact with someone who has tested positive to Coronavirus please Self Isolate for 10 days.

If you have taken a test, or have any reason to go for a test, and are asymptomatic please Self Isolate with the whole family for 10 days or until you receive a negative result.

It is important to stick to these times so that pupils the correct number of hours in school We would be very grateful if you send any test results into school before returning your child to school.

Staff are asked to take Lateral Flow Covid test twice weekly.

Please make sure your contact numbers are up to date. We may need to contact you quickly in the case of a bubble closure.

We have only have 2 bubble closures since the pandemic began so a huge thank you to everyone in the school community for all your efforts to keep us all safe.

Pick up and drop off arrangements.

Masks must be worn on school premises.

Adults must socially distance around school.

Children can only bring the following into school. Please make sure they are carrying everything and are ready to come in when you get to the gate.

- Clear water bottle (water only)
- Lunch box (healthy lunch)
- Coat
- Homework and reading books (days given by class teachers)

Children should come in their Forest school clothes on the day and KS2 come in PE kits on these days. KS1 can bring a PR kit in on Monday's and take it home on a Friday.

Social distancing and Self Isolation

We have worked really hard to keep our school community safe so far. Please be careful to maintain **social distancing** in front of school, on the playground, going through the playground gate or walking down the exit pathway.

To protect all the other parents and children **masks** must be worn from the front gates. (Please send medical exemption proof to the office if you cannot wear one).

Ventilation and hygiene

Windows will continue to be open well ventilated classrooms, the children can wear layers under school uniform on cold days. The children and staff will continue to use hand gel and wash their hands frequently throughout the day. Children are given their own stationary and books and other items are cleaned after each child using them.

Uniform

We would like the children in school uniform and school shoes but understand how difficult this might be for you all during the stage of the lockdown. If you do not have a school uniform that fits your child we have a few spare in school, otherwise plain clothes, not branded, can be worn until the non-essential shops re-open. We expect all children to be back in full uniform after the Easter holiday.

Attendance

It will be mandatory for all children to attend school, unless they have a good reason otherwise, this includes suspected symptoms, Self Isolation, Sickness or if your children is Clinically Extremely Vulnerable.

Laptops

Any families who have borrowed laptops please can these be returned on Monday 8th, with their adapter, plugs and cases.
