Year 3 Curriculum Overview Summer 1

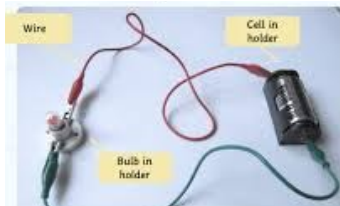

Maths

During this half term, we will be continuing our work on fractions. We will learn how to add and subtract fractions including fractions with mixed numbers. Following this we will be moving onto working with decimal numbers, money and time.

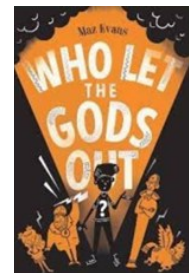

English

High Quality Text: Who Let the Gods Out

Recount writing: We will be looking at how to write a recount in the form of a newspaper article and the correct features. We will be focusing on the use of subordinating conjunctions and the correct way to punctuate quotations within a newspaper report.

Information Text: We will be looking at information texts. The children will be learning about all the features of information text and will be writing their own information text about a Greek God.



History

What did the Ancient Egyptians believe?

In this unit, we will be exploring who the Ancient Egyptians were and when they lived. We will look at the importance of the Egyptian Gods and Goddesses, along why and how the pyramids were built. We will explore the Book of the Dead and what this tells us about Egyptian beliefs.

Music

Pentatonic Melodies and Composition

The children will be learning about the music used to celebrate the Chinese New Year. We will learn how to play a Pentatonic scale using letter name and rhythmic notation to label and record our compositions. We will showcase our learning by performing our compositions as a group.
