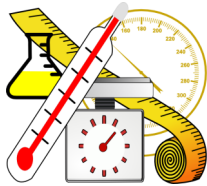

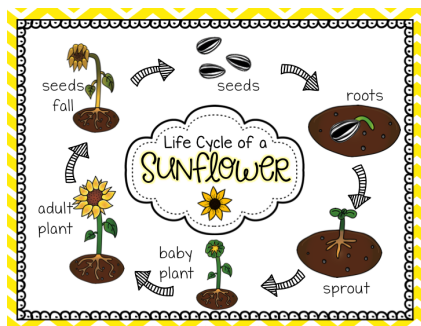
Spring term coverage: Time, Measurement, statistics

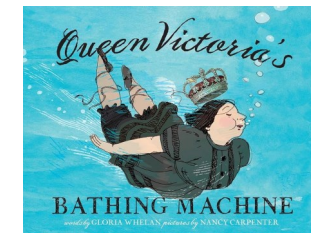
High Quality Texts: Queen Victoria's Bathing Machine by Gloria Whelan

Design and Technology

Textile pouches
