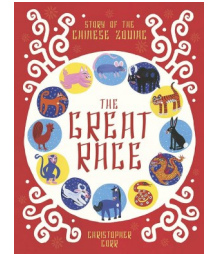

Design and Technology

Textiles: Puppets

Children will be designing and creating their own puppets based on the animals in the Chinese Zodiac.

Investigating Science Through Stories
