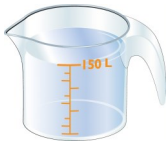
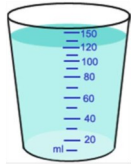

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Maths

Plants: Plant Growth.

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Religious Education

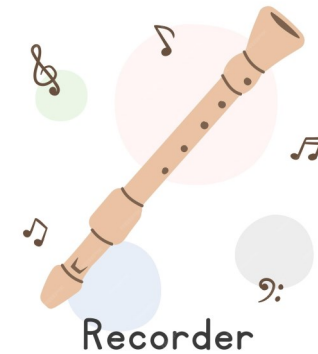
The Church
