Year 4 Curriculum Overview Summer 2

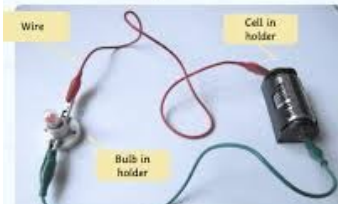

Maths

During this half term, we will be learning about time. We will start by looking at relationships between a year, a month, a week and a day, moving onto converting between 12 and 24 hour clocks. After time we will move onto Shape and then Position and direction.

Ongoing: Key focus on times tables, arithmetic, reasoning and problem solving.



Science

Classification and changing habitats

We will be learning about how we can group living things in a variety of different ways. We will then move onto recognizing and describing different habitats and their inhabitants. We will work scientifically in order to gather, record and classify data.

We will explore how habitats have changed. Covering the impact humans have had along with natural disasters.

Exploring local habitats



History

What did the Ancient Egyptians believe?

In this unit, we will be exploring who the Ancient Egyptians were and when they lived. We will look at the importance of the Egyptian Gods and Goddesses, along why and how the pyramids were built. We will explore the Book of the Dead and what this tells us about Egyptian beliefs.

Geography

Why are the rainforests important to us?

We will learn to, identify the location and some key features of the Amazon rainforest. Along with naming and describing the four layers of tropical rainforests. We will explore why the Amazon rainforest is important and how it is changing.

English

High Quality Text: Who Let the Gods Out

Information Text: We will be looking at information texts. The children will be learning about all the features of information text and will be writing their own information text about a Greek God.

Persuasive Text: We will be creating a shop advertisement based on part of the story from Who Let the Gods Out! First, we will learn about different persuasive techniques we can use in our writing.



Music

Samba Carnival Sounds and Instruments

The children will be learning about the main features of Samba music. We will be leaning about rhythm and creating our own syncopated rhythm.

Adapting and Transposing Motifs

The children will learn a new song, singing in time and in tune while following the lyrics. Identify motifs aurally and play a repeated pattern on a tuned instrument.

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Religious Education The Church

This term children will gain an understanding of the Christian church in its widest sense. We will develop our knowledge of sacred places of worship across world faiths.

Prayer

We will look at how believers across all world faiths pray in similar and different ways.



Computing

Data handling and online safety

During this term, children will learn to Search the web efficiently to find temperatures of different cities and record this accurately. We will move onto, describing how we can use the internet to search over multiple platforms and be aware of the accuracy of the results presented.

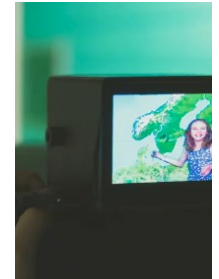
Homework and Reading
