The Day the Crayons Came Home is a story written by Oliver Jefferies, about a young boy called Duncan who has a special pack of crayons. In his previous story, Duncan's crayons leave home as they are fed up with not being treated properly. In this book, the crayons write Duncan a range of postcards from their destinations expressing their feelings and talking about coming home.

Science

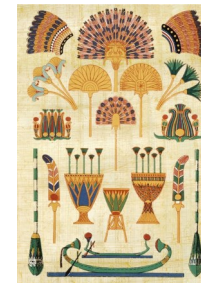
Making Connections: Does hand span affect grip strength?

Digital Literacy

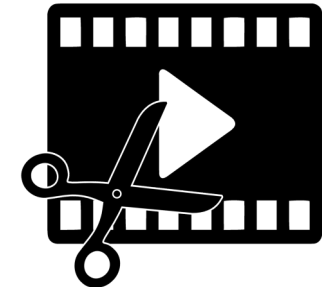
The children will be working this term towards a video which will reflect our English unit. The children will be working on creating media and will explore all the things needed to make a video and the role of technology.
