### English

The texts that we will be reading this term are:

Daily phonics/reading lessons will also be taking place.



### Art

#### Painting- Colour Splash

In Art this term our end product will be a painted plate.

Children will be looking at colour; learning how to mix paints to create secondary colours using primary colours.



### Science

#### Sensitive Bodies

In this topic, children will look at the human body and our five senses: taste, touch, smell, sight and hearing. We will look at the different parts of our body that affect these senses.
