Science

Comparing Animals

In Science we will be looking at a variety of common animals (including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals). We will be looking at the main body parts of common animals (arms, legs, wings etc), as well as looking at the different feeding habits of animals.



English

The texts that we will be reading this term are:

I Want My Hat Back- Jon Klassen

Dogger- Shirley Hughes

We will be writing about these stories in English.

Daily phonics/reading lessons will also be taking place.



DT

Moving Story Book

In DT this term our end product will be a moving story book.

Children will be learning about mechanisms; using bridges or guides to control the movement.

We will then use these to design a moving storybook for a given audience.

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Religious Education

Easter

During this term, we will be looking at the Easter story and why this is such an important story in the Bible. We will be looking at the connections between Easter and the new life of spring and will discuss why Christians believe Easter is a new beginning.



Music

Timbre and Rhythmic Patterns

Through fairytales, we will be looking at the concept of sound patterns (rhythms). We will learn how to clap along to repeated words and phrases, creating rhythmic patterns to tell a familiar fairytale.



Phonics

We will be recapping our Phonics learning from Reception. We will revisit our sounds and how segmenting and blending can assist in our reading.

This is also in preparation for the Phonics Screening in summer.

Geography

What is the weather like in the UK?

During this term, we will be learning how to identify and locate the four UK countries and describe locations using basic compass directions.

We will learn how to measure different types of weather; using symbols used in weather forecasts.

We will also learn how to describe seasonal changes and make suggestions of appropriate clothing and activities for each season.
