

### Maths

**Autumn Term Coverage: Addition and Subtraction, Shapes.**

Children are continuing to understand number bonds, in this unit we will connect our number bonds we already know to 10 and how this relates to our number bonds to 100. In geometry we will look deeper at 3-D shapes, and their properties.


### Wow Moment!




### English
