Maths




English

Newspaper Report: We will be exploring the features of a newspaper report before attempting to write our own based on the events in the story. The children will have the opportunity to engage with the text before starting to write.

Letter: We will be drafting a letter from the point of view of a character from the story.



Design and Technology

During this term, we will be looking at structures. We will be focusing on castles and how they are built. The children will spend time exploring the dynamics of the structure before having a try at building their own.
