
English

High Quality Text: Charlotte's Web

We will be reading and studying the classic novel Charlotte's Web during our spring term. We will spend some time reading the story and building our comprehension skills using questions on retrieval and inference, and expanding our vocabulary.

Letter writing: We will be drafting and writing a letter based on the events in the story.

Story retell: We will be using our knowledge of the text and the skills taught in our lessons to retell the story.



PSHE

This term we will be exploring how we keep ourselves safe. We will be discussing different ways to manage risky situations, identifying why some medicines are harmless and why some are harmful, and how we can keep ourselves safe online.

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Religious Education

Music

This term we will be learning how to play pentatonic melodies using a glockenspiel. The children will be exploring Chinese New Year and will work on matching their movements with pieces of music appropriately. To end the unit the children will work together to perform a piece of music.

Art

Prehistoric painting

In art, we will be exploring prehistoric art, recreating the style of cave artists using charcoal and natural pigments. Pupils will experiment with colour mixing, and creating large-scale artwork which will enhance both artistic skills and historical knowledge.
