
Ongoing: Arithmetic, reasoning and problem solving, and times tables. (Focus on 4s and 6s and 8s).

Why do people live near volcanoes?


In this unit we are learning about the structure of the Earth. We will be looking at how volcanoes and mountains are formed and the positives and negatives of living near a volcano. We will be looking at earthquakes and what causes an earthquake and discussing the qualities a building needs for it to be suitable near tectonic boundaries.

English

High Quality Text: Escape from Pompeii.

Non-chronological report: We will be exploring the features of a non-chronological report and creating our own based on the city of Pompeii and Mount Vesuvius.

Diary: We will be exploring the features and writing a diary entry from the point of view of one of the main characters in the story.



Design and Technology

During this term, we will be looking at pneumatic toys. They will be focusing on what components and materials are needed to create a desired motion in an object based on a design brief.
