Introduction to Plants

In Science we will be looking at a variety of common plants; including trees.

Art

Sculpture: Paper Play

In Art we will be looking at and making paper-based 3D art forms, focusing on techniques like rolling paper tubes, shaping paper strips, and constructing imaginative sculptures based on the work of artist Samantha Stephenson.



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Religious Education

Baptism

During this term, we will be looking at the baptism of Jesus.

We will look at the ways in which different religions and cultures celebrate the arrival of a new baby, including baptism in Christianity.



Music

Pitch and Tempo

This term we will learn how to identify high and low notes in order to compose a simple tune.

We will also use our bodies and instruments to listen and respond to pieces of music with fast and slow speeds; learning and performing a rhyme and a song focussing on fast and slow.



Phonics

We will be recapping our Phonics learning from Reception. We will revisit our sounds and how segmenting and blending can assist in our reading.

This is also in preparation for the Phonics Screening in summer.
