### Maths

#### Fractions

Pupils develop an understanding of fractions as equal parts of a whole. They learn to recognise, find, name, and write fractions such as  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{2}{4}$ , and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of shapes and quantities. Children also begin comparing and reasoning about simple fractions in practical contexts.

#### Time

Children learn to tell the time to the hour, half hour, quarter past, and quarter to, progressing to telling time to five minutes. They explore hours, minutes, and seconds, compare durations of events, and begin solving practical problems involving time.





### English

#### High Quality Text: NORTH—The Amazing Story of Arctic Migration

Children will explore the class text, which focuses on the Arctic migration of various animals, through reading, discussion, and writing. They will build their vocabulary, deepen their reading comprehension, and develop their non-fiction writing skills.

To begin, pupils will learn about the features of information leaflets and use this knowledge to create their own leaflet about an animal featured in the text.

Later in the unit, the children will turn their attention to poetry, using rich language and imagery to write their own poems inspired by the Arctic landscape and migrating animals.

### Science

#### Plants and Plant Growth

Learners explore the life cycle of plants, identifying basic parts and understanding what plants need to grow. They carry out simple investigations, make observations, and record growth over time.

### History

#### What is a Monarch?

Pupils explore the concept of monarchy by learning about significant British monarchs, including their roles, achievements, and impact on society. They develop an understanding of leadership and chronology through key historical figures and events.

### Art and Design

#### Sculpture and 3D: Clay Houses

Children investigate different types of homes and architecture before designing and creating their own 3D clay house sculptures. They learn key sculpting techniques such as rolling, joining, and etching.
