Maths

During this half term, we will be securing our understanding of fractions then moving onto mass and capacity. The children will be using a number of different manipulatives to embed their learning and aid their progression.

Ongoing: Arithmetic, reasoning and problem solving, and times tables. (Focus on 4s and 8s.)



Science

Plant Reproduction

We will be looking at the different parts of different plants and what they need to grow effectively. We will be focusing on the journey the water goes on through the different parts of the plant, when being watered. We will also be looking at the job of pollen and working on understanding the different ways that seeds can be spread.

History

Why did the Romans invade and settle in Britain?

During this term, we will be exploring the Romans, the things that were important to them, the structure routine and equipment used in the army and the reasons why the Romans invaded Britain. The children will be looking at a range of different artefacts to find out the experiences Roman soldiers had.

English

High Quality Text: The Boy Who Grew Dragons by Andy Shepherd.

Instruction writing: We will be looking at how to write instructions and what words/phrases are often used. We will be focusing on the use of timed adverbials and chronological ordering.

Poetry: We will be exploring a range of different poems and using these to inspire us to create our own rhyming poem based on 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons'.



Music

Samba and carnival sounds and instruments

During this term, we will be learning what samba music is and the different types of instruments used to compose sound. We will be working towards composing a piece of music using a beat and layers and working together with accuracy, control and fluency.

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Religious Education

Rules for living

This term in RE we will be focusing on how having rules is important in day to day life and how much following rules help us. We will be looking at the 10 commandments and how these helped to shape the lives of Christians.



Computing

Video trailers

This term we will be creating our own video trailer based on one of our books we have read across the year. The children will be learning how to use different features including text/captions, sound effects and how to edit into a video trailer which they have recorded.
