
High Quality Texts: The Great Race - Christopher Corr

Textiles: Puppets

Children will be designing and creating their own puppets based on the animals in the Chinese Zodiac.

They will learn how to cut, join and decorate fabric to make their own character from the story - The Great Race.



Music

Sound Patterns in Fairytales

In this unit, children will be introduced to the concept of sound patterns (rhythms). They will explore clapping along to repeated words and phrases.

Lessons include:

- Making changes to voices to represent a character.
- Choosing a suitable instrument to represent a part of a story.
- Play along with sounds and spoken words

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Religious Education

Creation

Children will be exploring the stories of Creation in Christianity, Hinduism and Islam.

They will take time to look at God's beautiful creation and have discussions on ways in which humans have made it better or worse.
