

Maths

In Maths, we will be working on money, time, shape and statistics. We will be exploring the concepts of these topics and using the four operations of Maths to solve problems and reason.

We will be continuing to work on our times tables focusing on 3s, 4, and 8s in particular.



Science

We will be focusing on the journey the water goes on through the different parts of the plant, when being watered. We will also be looking at the job of pollen and working on understanding the different ways that seeds can be spread.

Geography

Are all settlements the same?

In this unit we will be exploring the different types of settlements and what makes them all different. The children will be able to identify key features of towns, cities and villages. The children will then compare a local settlement to one in another geographical location.


English

High Quality Text: Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory is a novel written by Roald Dahl that focuses on the journey of a young boy and his family as they explore the local chocolate factory.

Character and setting description: We will be studying the character in depth, focusing on their physical features and inner qualities to create a character setting. The children will be working on similes and will use these within their writing.

Narrative rewrite: We will be studying the novel before attempting to rewrite a chapter using an alternative character/ending.



D/T

In DT we will be looking at electrical posters and how they are used in the community to advertise and make places more exciting. We will end the topic by designing our own.

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Religious Education

Is the book of proverbs still relevant?

We will be exploring the concept of the book of proverbs and discussing if they are still relevant. The children will be exploring the story of Solomon and his wisdom.

We will be carrying our unit from Summer 1 into Summer 2 and will be finishing our video trailers based on a book.


