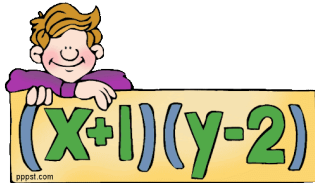

Spring term coverage: Algebra and Ratio

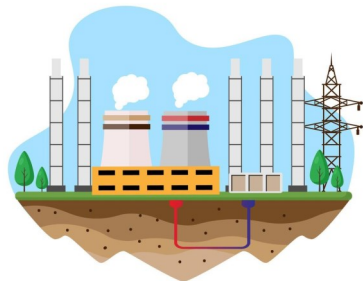

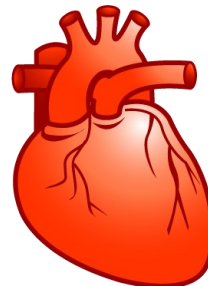

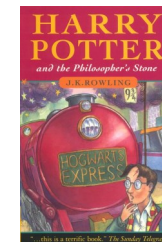
