Spring 1 coverage: Fractions and Multiplication and Division

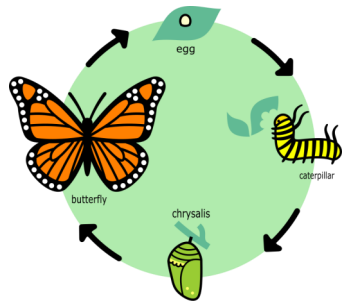
Ongoing: Arithmetic, Reasoning and Times Tables - Thank you for continuing to support learning at home via homework.

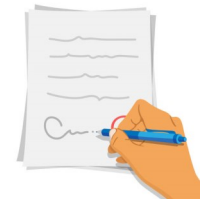
