Maths

Place value - We will review numbers up to 1000 and then move onto the place value of numbers up to 10,000. We will look at representing numbers using different mathematical equipment moving onto partition numbers into thousands, hundreds, tens and ones in different ways. Finally we will use our knowledge of place value to find 1, 10, 100 or 1000 more or less.

After place value we will move onto addition and subtraction looking at adding and subtracting 2 4 digit numbers.

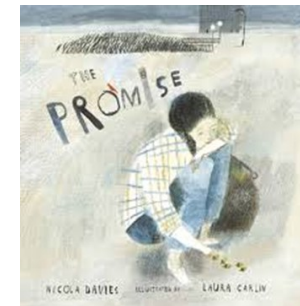

High Quality Text: The Promise by Nicola Davies

Narrative writing: We will be looking at how to write our own picture book story based on the book, The Promise. Focus grammar skills this term will be using a range of conjunctions to extend our sentences. Secondly, we will be adding detail in our writing using adjectives and expanded noun phrases.



Science

Animals: Digestion and Food

In this unit, the children will be exploring the role of the digestive system and comparing teeth and diets of different animals. We will investigate dental hygiene and recognize that difference in teeth relate to an animals diet. We will investigate food chains that recognize producers, predators and prey. We will be working scientifically to produce a results table of observations on what animal poo can tell us about digestion.

History

How hard was it to invade and settle in Britain?

In this unit, children will start by looking at how Britons felt when the Romans left Britain. We will research why the Anglo-Saxons invaded Britain and what their settlements looked like. We will look at how the Anglo-Saxon beliefs changed and how missionaries spread Christianity.

During this term, we will be exploring tone, texture and proportion to create realistic drawings.
