### Science

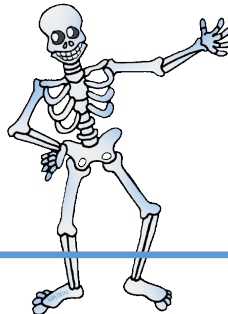
#### Movement and nutrition

### English

#### Writing: High Quality Texts: Hansel and Gretel by Anthony Browne

This Autumn half term, students will explore A retelling of this famous, dark fairytale from award-winning author-illustrator Anthony Browne.

Pupils will expand their vocabulary by describing characters and settings before crafting their own traditional tales.

Reading: Weekly Whole Class Reading Lessons and opportunities for reading for pleasure.

### History

#### British history 1: Would you prefer to have lived in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age?

This half term, Year 3 students will explore prehistory, the period of time before written methods that stretches until the Roman invasion in AD43.

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### Physical Education

#### Swimming

This half term children will be taught to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, using a range of strokes effectively.



### Computing

#### Online safety: Year 3

Pupils will learn how to enhance their online safety by adjusting privacy settings to safeguard their personal information. Additionally, they will develop skills to identify fake news.

### PSHE/SCARF

#### My Relationships

During this unit, the children will be encouraged to reflect on their relationships with others.

### Religious Education

#### Harvest: How do different faiths celebrate Harvest?

We will explore the celebration of the annual harvest, particularly in Britain, while examining the multi-faith dimensions of this event. Our study will compare how the tradition is honoured across the globe, including the construction of a Sukkah.

### Homework and Reading

Please make sure children continue to complete their homework weekly and reading books are returned daily.

### Music

#### Ballads

In this unit, children will explore the essence of ballads, learn to identify their distinctive features, and discover how to express various emotions during their performance.

### Art and Design

#### Prehistoric painting

This unit explores prehistoric art, recreating the style of cave artists using charcoal and natural pigments. Pupils experiment with colour mixing, and creating large-scale artworks, enhancing both artistic skills and historical knowledge.
