Maths

Place Value: Pupils will look closely at numbers to 100. They will learn to read and write these numbers as words and numerals. They will then look at how numbers are made up of tens and ones, using a variety of practical resources. They will use < > and = to compare the size of numbers and look at ordering them in size.

Addition and Subtraction: Pupils will learn how to add and subtract ones and tens from a 2-digit number, using practical resources, visuals and mental strategies.

Ongoing- Counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s.

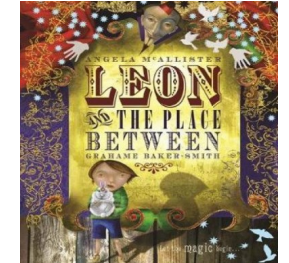
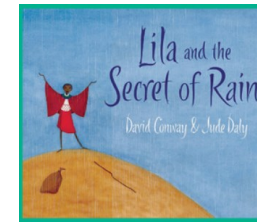


English

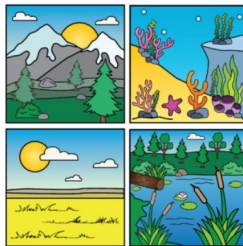
Later on in the term, pupils will start to study 'Leon and the place between'.

Habitats

Pupils will look at life processes, giving examples of how they apply to plants and animals. They will match different plants and animals to their habitats and talk about how animals use their habitat for food and shelter. They will start to create simple food chains.

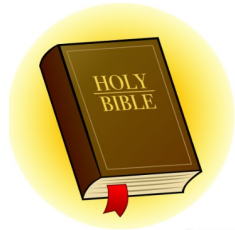

The Bible—Why is the Bible such a special book?

In this unit, Year 2 will widen their understanding of the Bible, its contents, presentation and importance to Christians. They will then look at other holy books in the lives of people of other world faiths.



Computing

What is a computer? - Year 2 will learn about the different components of a computer and how they work. They will look at how computers are used in the wider world.

Algorithms and De-Bugging—Childre will learn how computers make predictions. They will learn how to set their own instructions and learn about how 'abstraction' is removing any unnecessary detail to solve a problem.

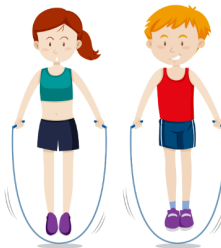

Physical Education

Fundamental Skills—Year 2 will focus on key skills such as running at different speeds, changing direction, dodging, balance, jumping and landing safely.
