Maths

During this half term we will be working on addition and subtraction of numbers within 10. We will be exploring different ways of adding and subtracting numbers and expanding our mathematical vocabulary. We will be doing ongoing work throughout the school year on number bonds, counting and will begin to explore our twos and fives.

Religious Education

Christmas

Physical Education
