## Science

Living things:  
Classifying big and small



This term, children will explore how living things are classified. They'll learn about the seven life processes, vertebrates and invertebrates, plant groups, and micro-organisms. We'll study Carl Linnaeus and how to group organisms using classification keys, with children creating simple keys of their own.

## History

What can the census tell us about local areas?

In this topic, we will using census data to explore changes between periods of time and use this to plan a local history enquiry. We will also use a range of sources to identify what life was like for Victorian children.

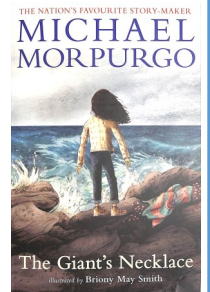
High Quality Texts: The Giant's Necklace by Michael Morpurgo

#### History of computers

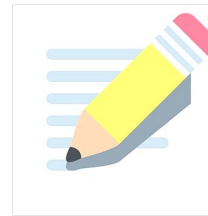
