### Maths

During this half term we will be working on shape and place value for numbers up to 20. We will be using a range of manipulatives to support their learning and to help them understand the composition of numbers to 20.

We will be doing ongoing work throughout the school year on number bonds, counting and will begin to explore our twos and fives.

### Science

#### Sensitive Bodies

In this topic, we will be exploring the body and learning about all the different body parts. We will be focusing on the sense and exploring what each of the 5 senses does. We will then be using our findings to spot a pattern.

As part of our History unit we will be having a teddy bears picnic!



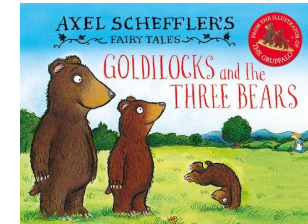
### Homework and Reading

### Religious Education

#### What made Jesus special?

During this unit we will be exploring Jesus and what made him special. We will be learning all about Jesus, his relationships with his friends and how they followed his teachings. We will be reading lots of bible stories and learning through relating to our own experiences.



### Physical Education

In PE the children will be working on their fundamental skills of movement. We will be playing a range of different games and doing a range of different activities to help improve fine and gross motor skills.

### History

#### How have toys changed?

### Computing

### Phonics

We have been working on Phase 4 and 5 of our phonics and the children have been working on adjacent consonants. We are practicing writing a range of CVCC and CCVCC words.
