Spring 2 coverage: Fractions, Decimals and percentages and Area/Perimeter

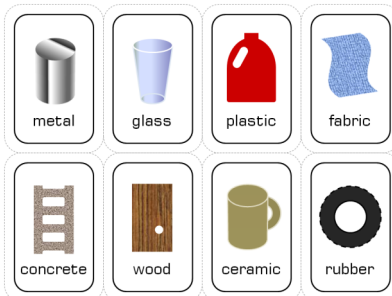
Ongoing: Arithmetic, Reasoning and Times Tables - Thank you for continuing to support learning at home via homework.

Easter: Why do Christians believe that Easter is a celebration of victory?

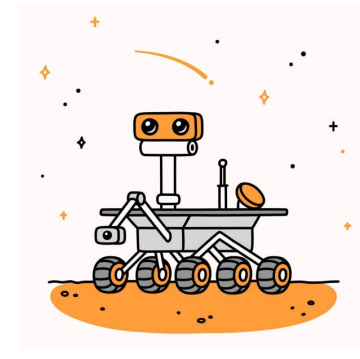
In this unit, children will explore the importance of Jesus' death and resurrection and understand Christ's triumph over death.
