Maths

Multiplication and Division—We will continue working on multiplication looking at the 11 and 12 times tables. Then, we will move onto looking at written methods for multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers.

Material: States of Matter

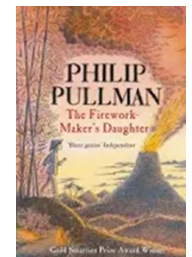
