Maths

Homework and Reading

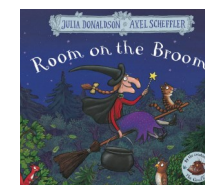
Please make sure children continue to complete their homework weekly and reading books are returned daily.

English

Room on the Broom by Julia Donaldson.

We will be continuing our work on sentence structure and developing our independence in writing. During this unit the children will be exploring conjunctions.

We will also be doing weekly comprehension lessons to build the children's inference and retrieval skills.



Art and Design

Sculpture and 3D art

In Art we will be looking at and making paper-based 3D art forms, focusing on techniques like rolling paper tubes, shaping paper strips, and constructing imaginative sculptures based on the work of artist Samantha Stephenson.



Science

Introduction to Plants

In Science we will be looking at a variety of common plants; including trees. We will look at how plants grow and change over time, including what they need to grow and look at the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees.

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Religious Education

Baptism

During this term, we will be looking at the baptism of Jesus. We will look at the ways in which different religions and cultures celebrate the arrival of a new baby, including baptism in Christianity.



Music

Pitch and Tempo

This term we will learn how to identify high and low notes in order to compose a simple tune. We will also use our bodies and instruments to listen and respond to pieces of music with fast and slow speeds; learning and performing a rhyme and a song focusing on fast and slow.



Phonics

We have been working on Phase 5 of our phonics. We will be moving onto soft, long and short sounds in preparation for the phonics screening check.
