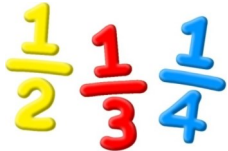

Maths

Mass, capacity and temperature: Children will measure mass in g /kgs. They will measure capacity in ml/l. Once again, they will apply their learning into the four operations.

Fractions: Children will learn about halves, quarters and thirds. They will be able to recognise fractions of shapes, quantities and numbers. They will recognise unit and non-unit fractions and also start to learn about 'equivalent fractions'.

Addition/Subtraction: Children will recap objectives from Autumn Term. They will start to add two 2-digit number together that cross ten, so will need to 'exchange'.

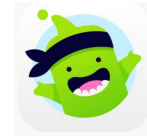

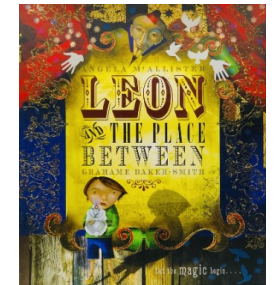
Creating microhabitats for mini-beasts with Mr Jarmesty.



English

Emotion Poems: Children will listen to 'I am angry' by Michael Rosen. They will explore different emotions and write a poem using different sentence types about emotions.

Leon and the Place Between: Children will recap this story from Autumn Term. They will explore expanded noun phrases and write a descriptive diary of what happened when Leon went to the place between.



Science

Microhabitats

Building upon Year 2's Autumn Topic of 'Habitats', children will explore a range of mini-beasts that live in smaller habitats called 'Microhabitats'. They will go on a minibeast hunt around school and then plan their own experiments. Finally, to end the topic, they will learn about the job of a 'botanist'.



Geography

What is it like to live by the coast?

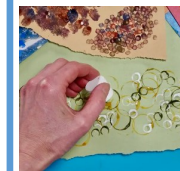
In this unit, Year 2 will learn about the seas and oceans that surround the United Kingdom. They will explore what 'the coast' means and the physical and human features that are linked to coastal places. They will take part in some field work, where they will investigate what attracts people to coastal places and present their findings.



Art

Life in Colour (Painting)

This unit focuses on primary and secondary colours, colour mixing, and creating textures using different tools. Children will experiment with materials to create collage and evaluate their artistic choices.



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Religious Education

Why is the church a special place for Christians?

In this unit, Year 2 will think about their own 'special places' and what makes them special. They will think about why the church is special to Christians. They will explore the idea that 'the church is the people, not the building'. We will hopefully be able to visit St Anne's church as part of this topic too! They will end the topic by linking this to other faiths and looking at their 'special places', for example: mosques and synagogues.

Homework and Reading



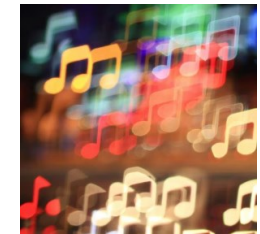
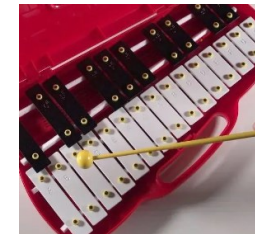
Purple homework books will be sent out on Fridays and must be returned the following Thursday.
