Mathematics

In our remaining Year 3 mathematics units, children will explore Roman numerals to 12, tell the time to 5 minutes and the minute, read digital clocks, use am and pm, and measure years, months, days, hours and minutes, while investigating turns, angles, shapes, pictograms, bar charts and two-way tables.

This half term, we will continue to practice multiplication tables in preparation for the Year 4

Science

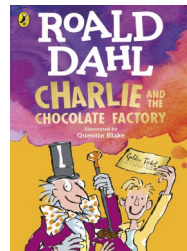
Plant reproduction.

In Science, we will continue our exciting work on plant reproduction from last term. We will explore how water is transported in plants, discover the important role of flowers, describe how seeds are formed, and compare different ways seeds are dispersed.

Physical Education

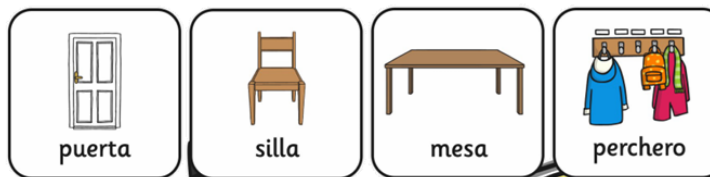
