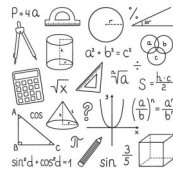

Geography

Unheard histories: Who should go on the £10 banknote?

In this unit, children will explore unheard histories, focusing on people who have made important contributions but are not always widely recognised. They will learn about different historical figures and consider why some are remembered more than others.

Children will use this knowledge to form and justify their own opinions about who should be featured on the £10 banknote, developing their skills in discussion, reasoning and decision-making.



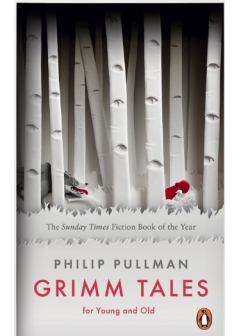

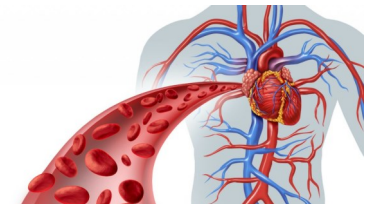
Weekly Whole Class Reading lessons and opportunities for reading for pleasure.

Science

Animals, including humans: Circulation and health

In this unit, children will learn about the circulatory system, including the role of the heart, blood and blood vessels. They will explore how oxygen and nutrients are transported around the body and why this is important for staying alive.

Children will also learn about healthy lifestyles, including the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and alcohol on the body, and how to make choices to keep themselves



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Religious Education

Ascension and Pentecost

In this unit, children will learn about Ascension and Pentecost, which are important events in Christianity. They will explore what Christians believe happened during these events and how the Holy Spirit is believed to inspire and transform people's lives. Children will retell these stories, discuss what they mean for Christians, and think about how beliefs can influence people's actions. They will also reflect on their own ideas about what inspires them and begin to explore bigger questions about God and belief.

In this unit, children will learn about big data and how information is collected, stored and used in the real world. They will explore how data can be analysed to find patterns and answer questions, as well as how it can influence decisions.
