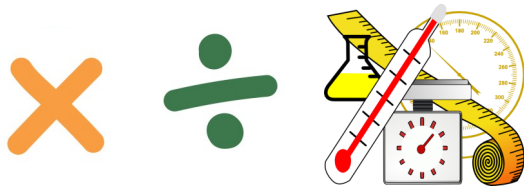

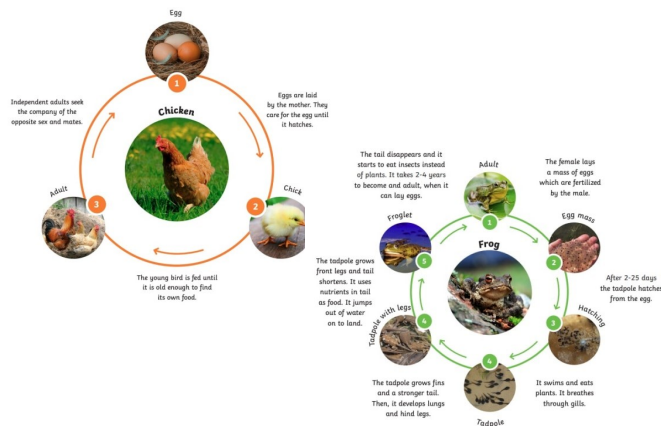
Wow Moment!

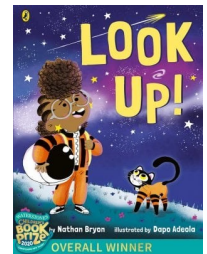
