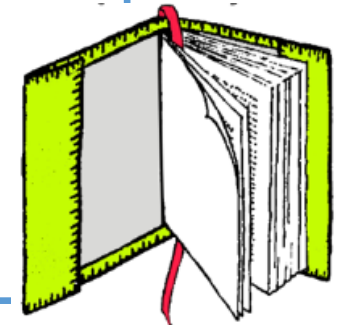
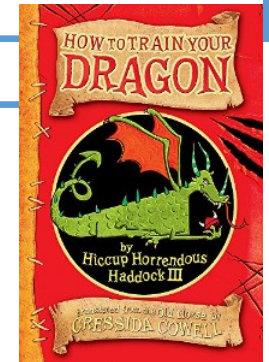


Design and Technology
