

## **Catch up premium: coronavirus (COVID-19)**

### **How we intend to spend this grant?**

Within Standish Lower Ground St Anne's CE Primary School we have identified specific cohort with the most immediate need. Working within our Covid-19 Risk Assessment we intend to use this funding to release our HLTA, by providing TA support in other classes. She will provide additional small group teaching, focusing on maths and English, for our Year 5 and 6 children. This will enable her to remain within this double bubble, whilst having a teaching base in the school hall, limiting virus spread throughout the school.

### **How will this spending effect the educational attainment of our pupils?**

Our HLTA, is highly experienced and attends all up to date training and meetings regarding English and maths in our school. Working with the class teachers she will support small groups of upper KS2 children and help them to make speedy progress within these key areas of the curriculum.
